Senate Bill 20

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt radon mitigation standards for certain new buildings.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to radon mitigation in buildings.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.

5 SECTION 2. (1) The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall

6 adopt design and construction standards for mitigating radon levels in new commercial

7 buildings that are intended for human occupancy and in new single-family and multifamily

8 residential buildings. When adopting the standards, the director shall give consideration to

9 any standards recommended by the United States Environmental Protection Agency for

10 radon mitigation systems in buildings.

(2) The director shall make the design and construction standards for mitigating radon
levels applicable in:

13 (a) Baker, Hood River, Multnomah, Polk and Yamhill Counties; and

(b) Any county for which the director considers the standards appropriate due to local
radon levels.

(3) The director may authorize a municipality that administers and enforces one or more
building inspection programs under ORS 455.148 or 455.150 to also administer and enforce
applicable radon mitigation standards adopted by the director.

(4) The director may adopt rules for the implementation, administration and enforcementof this section.

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
