75th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2009 Regular Session

Senate Bill 22

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Conditions and partially eliminates pesticide applicator licensing exemption for persons engaged in maintenance of small or home lawns, shrubs or gardens. Allows fee for pesticide trainee certificate to be less than fee for pesticide applicator license.

2	Relating to pesticides; amending ORS 634.106, 634.126 and 634.372.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 634.106 is amended to read:
5	634.106. ORS 634.112 to 634.126 and 634.146 [shall] do not apply to:
6	(1) Manufacturers of materials engaged in research or experimental work on pesticides.
7	(2) Persons engaged in the business of a pesticide operator or applicator only in the application
8	of any pollenicide.
9	(3) Persons licensed as veterinarians under ORS chapter 686 who are engaged in the practice
10	of veterinary medicine within the scope of their veterinary medicine practice and employees of li-
11	censed veterinarians when acting within the scope of their employment.
12	(4) A farmer or forestland owner applying pesticides, other than restricted-use pesticides, by use
13	of equipment of the farmer or forestland owner for others on an occasional basis not amounting to
14	a principal or regular occupation, if:
15	(a) The farmer does not publicly hold out as a pesticide applicator; and [if]
16	(b) The pesticides that are applied are furnished by the owner of the land [on which such] to
17	which the pesticides are applied.
