SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to classify fleeing or attempting to elude police officer as crime category 8 under certain circumstances.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sentencing guidelines.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall classify fleeing or attempting

5 to elude a police officer as described in ORS 811.540 as crime category 8 of the sentencing

6 guidelines grid of the commission if the driver of the motor vehicle:

7 (1) Has a prior conviction of fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer in violation

8 of ORS 811.540 (1)(b)(A);

9 (2) Was driving while under the influence of intoxicants in violation of ORS 813.010;

10 (3) Was driving while suspended or revoked in violation of ORS 811.175 or 811.182;

11 (4) Was driving at a speed equal to or greater than 80 miles per hour;

12 (5) Was engaged in conduct that would constitute a violation of ORS 811.140; or

13 (6) Had a passenger in the motor vehicle.

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to conduct occurring on or after the ef-15 fective date of this 2009 Act.
