## Senate Bill 415

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires chief administrative law judge to ensure training in water law for certain administrative law judges. Specifies number of hours of training required every two years.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The chief administrative law judge of the Office of Administrative 5 Hearings shall ensure that all administrative law judges assigned to conduct hearings on 6 behalf of the Water Resources Department or the Water Resources Commission have ap-7 propriate training in water law, including but not limited to training in federal and state 8 statutory law, case law, rules and policy issues.

9 (2) The training specified in subsection (1) of this section shall consist of \_\_\_\_\_ hours 10 every two years.
