Senate Bill 450

Sponsored by Senator KRUSE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for improving legal representation of parents and children in dependency cases. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to appointment of counsel in dependency cases; appropriating money; and declaring an
emergency.

4 Whereas improving parents' and children's legal representation in dependency cases increases

5 the percentage of children returned to parents and to a safe environment; and

6 Whereas improving parents' and children's legal representation in dependency cases reduces the 7 lengths of children's stays in foster care; and

8 Whereas improving parents' and children's legal representation in dependency cases increases 9 stable placements for children, including placements with their relatives; and

10 Whereas improving parents' and children's legal representation in dependency cases reduces

11 delays in the judicial system through a reduction in the number of continuances, a focus on relevant

12 issues and early adjudications and placements; now, therefore,

13 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

14 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-15 ated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out 16 of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the purpose of improving legal represen-

17 tation for parents and children in dependency cases.

18 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 20 July 1, 2009.
