## Senate Bill 510

Sponsored by Senator MORRISETTE; Representative BUCKLEY (at the request of Oregon Manufactured Homeowners United)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Removes prohibition against adoption, amendment or enforcement of local ordinance, rule or other local law regulating manufactured dwelling park closures or partial closures. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to local regulation of manufactured dwelling parks; creating new provisions; amending ORS

90.660; repealing section 5, chapter 906, Oregon Laws 2007; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 90.660 is amended to read:

90.660. [A local government may not enforce an ordinance, rule or other local law regulating manufactured dwelling park closures or partial closures adopted or amended by the local government on or after July 1, 2007.] A local government may adopt, amend and enforce an ordinance, rule or other local law for the regulation of manufactured dwelling park closures or partial closures that provides a manufactured dwelling park tenant with rights and benefits that are

in addition to, equal to or more favorable than the rights and benefits provided to the park tenant under ORS 90.645 or 90.655. A local government may not enforce an ordinance, rule or other local law [regulating] for the regulation of manufactured dwelling park closures or partial closures [may not be applied to reduce the rights] that reduces the rights and benefits provided to a park tenant under ORS 90.645 or 90.655.

16 SECTION 2. Section 5, chapter 906, Oregon Laws 2007, is repealed.

17 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The amendments to ORS 90.660 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to the 18 enforcement of ordinances, rules and other local laws for the purpose of regulating manu-19 factured dwelling park closures or partial closures for which the landlord gives notice under 20 ORS 90.645 on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.

21 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 22 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 23 on its passage.

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
