HOUSE MINORITY REPORT AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 519

Speaker Hunt:

A minority of your Committee on Rules, to whom was referred A-engrossed Senate Bill 519, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that it do pass with the following amendments:

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete the period and insert "; and providing $\mathbf{2}$ that this Act shall be referred to the people for their approval or rejection. "Whereas employers drive the Oregon economy; and 3 "Whereas communications made by employers to employees are essential to operations; and 4 "Whereas federal law already prohibits employers from making threats or promises of benefits 5 to employees during a unionization campaign; and 6 7 "Whereas public policy has a direct effect on both employers and employees; now, therefore,". Delete lines 21 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert: 8 "SECTION 2. It is declared that it is the public policy of the State of Oregon that: 9 "(1) The state shall not interfere in communications between employers and employees; 10 "(2) The state shall not restrict the free speech communications of an employer; 11 12 "(3) The state shall not restrict the right of an employer to communicate to employees about how political matters or the activities of labor organizations could affect the activities 13 or functions of the employer or the employee; and 14 "(4) The state shall not restrict or limit any communication of religious matters by an 15 employer with a religious focus. 16 "SECTION 3.
