SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Expands range of activities that count as providing drug test falsification equipment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to drug test falsification; amending ORS 475.920.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475.920 is amended to read:

5 475.920. (1) A person commits the crime of providing drug test falsification equipment if the 6 person intentionally [delivers, possesses with intent to deliver or manufactures with intent to deliver]

7 manufactures, markets, sells, distributes, delivers, possesses with intent to market, sell,

8 distribute or deliver, or transports into this state, a substance or device designed to enable a

9 person to falsify the results of a drug test.

10 (2) Providing drug test falsification equipment is a Class A misdemeanor.
