SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 618

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "amending ORS 192.502;" and insert "creating new 1 $\mathbf{2}$ provisions; amending ORS 192.502 and 408.420;". 3 On page 6, line 37, after "(35)" insert "Except as authorized by section 3 of this 2009 Act,". 4 After line 38, insert: 5 "SECTION 2. ORS 408.420 is amended to read: 6 "408.420. Each county clerk shall maintain in the office a special book in which the county clerk 7 shall, upon request, record the final discharge of any [war] military veteran. No recording fee shall be collected when the [war] military veteran requesting [such] the record is an actual resident of 8 9 [said] the county or was [such] a resident at the time of entrance into the service of the United 10 States. In all other cases a legal fee shall be charged. There shall be kept in connection with 11 [such] the record[,] an alphabetical index referring to the name of the [soldier, sailor or marine] 12 military veteran whose name appears in each discharge paper so recorded. [Such] Books [as] that 13 are necessary for the recording of the discharge papers shall be paid for by the several counties in 14 the manner provided for paying other claims against the county. 15"SECTION 3. (1) Each county clerk who receives a request to inspect military veteran 16 discharge papers that are recorded under ORS 408.420 shall produce the recorded discharge 17 papers for inspection if: 18 "(a) The request for inspection is made in writing; 19 "(b) The request sets forth the name, address and telephone number of the requester; 20 "(c) The request sets forth the name and the date of birth or the last four digits of the 21Social Security number of the military veteran; and "(d) The request is made by: 2223 "(A) The military veteran or the spouse, legal guardian or personal representative of the 24 military veteran; 25"(B) A county veterans' service officer appointed under ORS 408.410; "(C) A representative of the Department of Veterans' Affairs; or 2627"(D) A licensed funeral establishment seeking to ascertain if a decedent was a veteran 28for the purpose of obtaining veteran's burial benefits. 29 "(2) This section does not create a cause of action and may not be asserted as the basis 30 of a per se negligence claim. 31 "(3) Each county clerk may adopt additional policies in order to protect recorded dis-32charge papers from malicious or unlawful use and policies regarding copying of recorded 33 discharge papers. 34 "(4) Each county clerk shall maintain in the records of the county clerk a copy of each 35request for inspection of recorded discharge information for a period of at least 10 years af-

- 1 ter the date the request is received by the county clerk.".
