## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires prepaid managed care health services organization to [reimburse community health center or safety net clinic for costs of services provided by center or clinic to enrollee of organization] contract with credentialed community health center or safety net clinic for provision of covered services by center or clinic to certain enrollees of organization if center or clinic agrees to contractual terms, conditions and reimbursement rates similar to those negotiated by organization with subcontractors providing same or similar services.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Community health center or safety net clinic" means a nonprofit medical clinic or
7	school-based health center that provides primary physical health, vision, dental or mental
8	health services to low-income patients without charge or using a sliding scale based on the
9	income of the patient.
10	(b) "Medical assistance" has the meaning given that term in ORS 414.025.
11	(c) "Prepaid managed care health services organization" has the meaning given that term
12	in ORS 414.736.
13	(2) A prepaid managed care health services organization shall contract with a community
14	health center or safety net clinic for the provision of covered services by the center or clinic
15	to an enrollee of the organization who is a recipient of medical assistance if the center or
16	clinic providers are credentialed by the organization and agree to contractual terms, condi-
17	tions and reimbursement rates similar to those negotiated by the organization with subcon-
18	tractors providing the same or similar services.
19	(3) The Department of Human Services shall adopt standards by rule for the contracts
20	entered into between centers or clinics and organizations under this section.
21	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to contracts entered into or renewed be-
22	tween the Department of Human Services and a prepaid managed care health services or-
23	ganization on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
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
