(b) 'Disabled veteran' means a person entitled to disability compensation under laws adminis-8 9 tered by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, a person whose discharge or release 10 from active duty was for a disability incurred or aggravated in the line of duty or a person who 11 was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in combat. 12 "(c) 'Public employer' means the state or any agency or political subdivision of the state and 13 any person authorized to act on behalf of the state or any agency or political subdivision of the state 14 with respect to control, management or supervision of any employee. 15"(d) 'Veteran' means a person who: 16 "(A) Served on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United States: 17 (i) For a period of more than 90 consecutive days beginning on or before January 31, 18 1955, and was discharged or released under honorable conditions; 19 "[(i)] (ii) For a period of more than 178 consecutive days beginning after January 31, 1955, 20 and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable conditions; 21"[(iii) For 178 days or less and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable 22conditions because of a service-connected disability; [or] 23 (iv) For 178 days or less and was discharged or released from active duty under honor-24 able conditions and has a disability rating from the United States Department of Veterans 25Affairs; or 26 "[(iii)] (v) For at least one day in a combat zone and was discharged or released from active 27duty under honorable conditions; [or] 28"(B) Received a combat or campaign ribbon or an expeditionary medal for service in the 29Armed Forces of the United States[.] and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable conditions; or 30 31 "(C) Is receiving a nonservice-connected pension from the United States Department of 32**Veterans Affairs.** "(2) As used in subsection (1)(d) of this section, 'active duty' does not include attendance at a 33 34 school under military orders, except schooling incident to an active enlistment or a regular tour of 35duty, or normal military training as a reserve officer or member of an organized reserve or a Na-
