Dear Chair Burdick and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of Clackamas County Business & Economic Development, I would like to share the reasons for our support of HB 3017.

We believe the program in its current form works very well as a business recruitment and expansion tool that offers an attractive incentive to traded sector businesses that provide well paying jobs with benefits and bring investment in our communities.

We recently completed a boundary expansion of the Milwaukie/North Clackamas Enterprise Zone brining the City of Happy Valley's Rock Creek Employment Area into the district. Clackamas County serves as the Zone Manager for Enterprise Zones in the communities of Milwaukie, Sandy, Molalla, and Estacada.

Combined to date, these Enterprise Zones have provided tax abatements to 20 companies, retained 2,822 jobs, created 678 jobs, and spurred over \$66 million in investment.
