HOUSE BILL 2572

Comments by Gil Riddell, Policy Coordinator, Association of Oregon Counties, before the Senate Finance & Revenue Committee, May 25, 2011.

The Association of Oregon Counties respectfully requests the Committee to pass House Bill 2572, for two very simple reasons.

What HB 2572 does not do:

The bill does not prohibit or otherwise affect the right of the taxpayer to appeal the value of just one component of their property (i.e., land or improvements).

What HB 2572 does do:

The bill permits the magistrate or judge in a property tax appeal to ensure the correct final valuation of property in the process of making the component value adjustment requested by the taxpayer.
