Representative Berger, I understand that the Joint Committee on Tax Credits which you Co-Chair will meet tomorrow for a public hearing on Senate Bill 317 regarding E-Commerce Tax Credits. I want you to know that this incentive is the "only" reason we were able to attract the Wachovia (Wells Fargo) Service Center which now has 600 + employees and the Garmin expansion a few months ago that will ultimately employ 200 + employees. These two projects alone show the critical importance of this EZ designation. Lastly, we are in the final stages of recruitment for a "Major" project in Salem that will use the E-Commerce designation for their EZ Application and ultimately fail if we cannot offer the incentive. You can see Representative Berger that the E-Commerce Tax Credit is of critical importance to our ability to recruit new industries into the region.
