Honorable Representatives Bailey and Berger,

I am the VP of Technical Operations for Bend Broadband, a local, family-owned business that has served Central Oregonians for more than 50 years. I also hold the position of project manager for the Bend Broadband Vault, which recently held its grand opening. The Vault is Central Oregon's premier and only Tier III, co-location data center that provides flexible, leased data center space to suit organizations from small and medium-sized businesses to enterprise-class companies. The Vault project would not have been possible without programs like the enterprise zone, Oregon Investment Advantage, and the ecommerce zone. Because of these incentives, Bend and Deschutes County receive \$15M in new investment, add six jobs at an average salary of \$70,000, offer high quality data center services to businesses throughout the western United States, and add a new export business sector.
