**Measure Description:**

Authorizes setting aside conviction for certain sex crimes and expungement of juvenile records related to adjudication for certain sex crimes under certain circumstances.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Judicial Department, Oregon State Police, Public Defense Services Commission

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill would allow the setting aside or expungement of juvenile records under certain circumstances. The circumstances are fairly narrow and it is not believed that this will be widely used. If it is, the Oregon State Police charge \$80 for each set aside or expungement. If the bill results in a substantial number of requests, they may need to return to the Legislative Assembly or a future Emergency Board for additional resources. The Oregon Judicial Department would have a minimal fiscal impact. Expungements and set asides are not eligible for public defense services, so the Public Defense Services Commission does not anticipate a fiscal impact.
