WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) to adopt rule establishing raffle, with prize of free hunting license, for hunters who report harvest and effort for previous hunting season.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Correlation between HB 2125 and HB 2126

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Beginning in 2008, ODFW adopted rules requiring licensed hunters to provide a report of their hunting activities to the department. Under current law, there is no penalty in place for non-compliance. House Bill 2126-A would encourage reporting by authorizing ODFW to raffle a free hunting license to hunters who report for the previous hunting season.
