**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows persons who use physical force in care or supervision of incompetent persons to be criminally charged.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of amendment

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Replaces the measure.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently there is an exception from criminal liability for parents, guardians, or other persons, for the use of reasonable physical force, reasonably believed to be necessary, against an incompetent adult in their care or under their supervision (ORS 161.205(1)). House Bill 2648 A eliminates this exception.
