EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Sergeant Richard J. Schuening died from explosion-related injuries he received while performing his duties as a Hazardous Devices Technician with the Oregon State Police on October 2, 1997.

A native Oregonian, Sergeant Schuening served in the Army National Guard and the Navy Submarine Service before pursuing a career in law enforcement. After graduating from Oregon State Police Recruit School in 1979, he served in a variety of law enforcement roles during his 18-year career as a member of the Oregon State Police, including patrol officer, criminal detective, arson investigator and bomb technician.
