

House Bill 2340

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Fish and Wildlife Commission by rule to establish schedule of wildlife propagation license fees for persons engaging in business of propagating animals of family Cervidae. Requires fees to be sufficient to cover expenses of administering and enforcing wildlife propagation license program as it relates to family Cervidae.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to wildlife propagation licenses; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 497.258.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 497.258 is amended to read:

5 497.258. The State Department of Fish and Wildlife is authorized to issue, upon application, to
6 persons desiring to engage in the following occupations the following licenses and shall charge
7 therefor the following fees:

8 (1) Resident annual fur dealer license, \$50.

9 (2) Resident annual taxidermist license, \$50.

10 (3) Resident annual wildlife propagation license, \$25, **except as provided in section 3 of this**
11 **2011 Act.**

12 (4) Resident annual fish propagation license, \$125.

13 (5) Resident annual private hunting preserve license, \$200.

14 **SECTION 2.** Section 3 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 497.

15 **SECTION 3.** The State Fish and Wildlife Commission by rule shall establish a schedule
16 of wildlife propagation license fees for persons engaging in the business of propagating ani-
17 mals of the family Cervidae. The commission shall establish fees for the issuance and re-
18 newal of the licenses in amounts reasonably calculated to reimburse the commission for the
19 costs of administering and enforcing the license program as it relates to the family Cervidae.

20 **SECTION 4.** The amendments to ORS 497.258 by section 1 of this 2011 Act and section 3
21 of this 2011 Act apply to wildlife propagation licenses for persons engaging in the business
22 of propagating animals of the family Cervidae that are renewed by, or first obtained from,
23 the State Department of Fish and Wildlife on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
