

# House Bill 2368

Sponsored by Representative NATHANSON; Representatives DEMBROW, DOHERTY, KOTEK (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Policy Board to convene work group to address unnecessary medical imaging.

Sunset January 2, 2013.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1

2 Relating to medical imaging.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Policy Board shall convene a work group to investigate**  
5 **and develop recommended strategies to reduce the number of unnecessary advanced medical**  
6 **imaging tests ordered, including but not limited to magnetic resonance imaging and**  
7 **cathode-ray tube scans.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed January 2, 2013.**
