

House Bill 2390

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes task force on health care reform.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to health care; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Health Care Reform is established, consisting of eight**
5 **members appointed as follows:**

6 (a) **The President of the Senate shall appoint three members.**

7 (b) **The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three members.**

8 (c) **The Governor shall appoint two members.**

9 (2) **The appointing authorities, in consultation with the task force chairperson, shall de-**
10 **velop a work plan consisting of a list of subjects for study by the task force. The task force,**
11 **by official action, may request a modification of the work plan. Only the appointing author-**
12 **ities, after consultation with the chairperson, may modify the work plan.**

13 (3) **A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the**
14 **transaction of business.**

15 (4) **Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting**
16 **members of the task force.**

17 (5) **The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

18 (6) **If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
19 **ment to become immediately effective.**

20 (7) **The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
21 **or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.**

22 (8) **The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

23 (9) **The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and to**
24 **the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than October 1,**
25 **2011.**

26 (10) **The Oregon Health Authority shall provide staff support to the task force.**

27 (11) **Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation, but may be reimbursed**
28 **for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of**
29 **their official duties in the manner and amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for ex-**
30 **penditures shall be paid out of funds appropriated to Oregon Health Authority for purposes of**
31 **the task force.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted.
New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
2 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
3 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
4 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

5 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2012**
6 **legislative session.**

7 **SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
9 **on its passage.**

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
