House Bill 3015

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (at the request of Waldon Perkins)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires annual report from each community college district and public institution of higher education on compliance with Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act. Requires deficiencies identified in report to be remedied by district or institution within one year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to post-secondary campus safety.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) Prior to July 1 of each calendar year, each community college district in this state shall submit a report to the State Board of Education documenting compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)). The report shall address all reporting requirements of the Act and any implementing federal regulations in a form established by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development.
 - (2) The report shall specifically note any areas of noncompliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)) and implementing federal regulations, and shall set forth a plan and schedule for compliance with the Act and regulations. Any noncompliance must be remedied within one year of the submission of the report.
 - SECTION 2. (1) Prior to July 1 of each calendar year, each state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 shall submit a report to the State Board of Higher Education documenting compliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)). The report shall address all reporting requirements of the Act and any implementing federal regulations in a form established by the Oregon University System.
 - (2) The report shall specifically note any areas of noncompliance with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)) and implementing federal regulations, and shall set forth a plan and schedule for compliance with the Act and regulations. Any noncompliance must be remedied within one year of the submission of the report.
 - SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2011 Act first apply to the 2012 calendar year.
