

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3417

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “327.297.”
- 2 On page 6, delete lines 8 through 45.
- 3 On page 7, delete lines 1 through 27 and insert:
- 4 **“SECTION 7.** ORS 338.155 is amended to read:
- 5 **“338.155. (1)(a)** Students of a public charter school shall be considered to be residents of the
- 6 school district in which the public charter school is located for purposes of distribution of the State
- 7 School Fund.
- 8 **“(b)(A) For the purpose of determining the amounts to be distributed from the State**
- 9 **School Fund to a school district in which a public charter school is located, the district ex-**
- 10 **tended ADMw described in ORS 327.013 shall be determined by:**
- 11 **“(i) Separately calculating the extended ADMw for students at the public charter school**
- 12 **and the extended ADMw for students at nonchartered public schools in the school district;**
- 13 **and**
- 14 **“(ii) Adding the extended ADMw for students at the public charter school and the ex-**
- 15 **tended ADMw for students at nonchartered public schools in the school district.**
- 16 **“(B) Except as provided in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph:**
- 17 **“(i) All other calculations made under ORS 327.013 shall be made as though the students**
- 18 **enrolled at a public charter school were students enrolled at the public schools in the school**
- 19 **district in which the public charter school is located; and**
- 20 **“(ii) All references to the district extended ADMw shall be based on the calculation made**
- 21 **under subparagraph (A)(ii) of this paragraph.**
- 22 **“(C) All amounts to be distributed from the State School Fund to public charter schools**
- 23 **shall first be distributed to the school district in which the public charter school is located.**
- 24 **“(2)** A school district shall contractually establish, with any public charter school that is spon-
- 25 sored by the board of the school district, payment for provision of educational services to the public
- 26 charter school’s students. The payment shall equal an amount per weighted average daily member-
- 27 ship (ADMw) of the public charter school that is at least equal to:
- 28 **“(a)** Eighty percent of the amount of the school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw as
- 29 calculated under ORS 327.013 for students who are enrolled in kindergarten through grade eight;
- 30 and
- 31 **“(b)** Ninety-five percent of the amount of the school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw
- 32 as calculated under ORS 327.013 for students who are enrolled in grades 9 through 12.
- 33 **“(3)** A school district shall contractually establish, with any public charter school that is spon-
- 34 sored by the State Board of Education and within the boundaries of the school district, payment for
- 35 provision of educational services to the public charter school’s students. The payment shall equal

1 an amount per weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of the public charter school that is at  
2 least equal to:

3 “(a) Ninety percent of the amount of the school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw as  
4 calculated under ORS 327.013 for students who are enrolled in kindergarten through grade eight;  
5 and

6 “(b) Ninety-five percent of the amount of the school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw  
7 as calculated under ORS 327.013 for students who are enrolled in grades 9 through 12.

8 “(4) The estimated amount of each school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw shall be  
9 determined each year by the Department of Education and made available to all school districts.

10 “(5) The school district in which the public charter school is located shall transfer an amount  
11 per weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of the public charter school that is equal to 50  
12 percent of the amount of the school district’s General Purpose Grant per ADMw as calculated under  
13 ORS 327.013 that is not paid to the public charter school through a contract created pursuant to  
14 subsections (2) or (3) of this section to:

15 “(a) Any school district in which the parent or guardian of or person in parental relationship  
16 to a student of a public charter school resides pursuant to ORS 339.133 and 339.134; or

17 “(b) The Department of Education if the State Board of Education is the sponsor of the public  
18 charter school.

19 “(6) The department may use any money received under this section for activities related to  
20 public charter schools.

21 “(7) A school district and a public charter school may negotiate to establish a payment for the  
22 provision of educational services to the public charter school’s students that is more than the min-  
23 imum amounts specified in subsection (2) or (3) of this section.

24 “(8) A school district shall send payment to a public charter school based on a contract nego-  
25 tiated under this section within 10 days after receiving payments from the State School Fund pur-  
26 suant to ORS 327.095.

27 “(9)(a) A public charter school may apply for any grant that is available to school districts or  
28 nonchartered public schools from the Department of Education. The department shall consider the  
29 application of the public charter school in the same manner as an application from a school district  
30 or nonchartered public school.

31 “(b) The department shall award any grant that is available to school districts based solely on  
32 the weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of the school district directly to the public charter  
33 school. This paragraph does not apply to any grant from the State School Fund.”.
