## **House Joint Memorial 20**

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Urges Congress to enact legislation requiring Federal Aviation Administration to expedite approval process for unmanned aircraft testing in rural areas.

## JOINT MEMORIAL

2 To the President of the United States and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United

3 States of America, in Congress assembled:

We, your memorialists, the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:

6 Whereas unmanned aircraft are currently prohibited from flying in general airspace; and

7 Whereas manufacturers of unmanned aircraft require locations for aerial testing; and

8 Whereas it usually takes two to five years to obtain Federal Aviation Administration approval 9 for testing of unmanned aircraft; and

10 Whereas central Oregon has proposed a large remote area for the testing of unmanned aircraft; 11 and

12 Whereas remote Military Operations Areas are available when not in use by the military; and

Whereas manufacturers of unmanned aircraft locating to central Oregon would bring immediate economic benefit to the proposed test area; and

15 Whereas the recent unemployment rate for communities near the proposed test area ranges from 16 a low of approximately 15 percent to a high of 18.6 percent; now, therefore,

## 17 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

(1) The Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to enact
 legislation that requires the Federal Aviation Administration to:

(a) Develop an expedited approval process for applications for aerial testing in rural counties
 with an unemployment rate of 10 percent or higher; and

(b) Expedite approval of temporary flight restrictions to allow unmanned aircraft testing in re mote Military Operations Areas when those areas are not in use by the military.

(2) A copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President of the United States, to the Senate
Majority Leader, to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and to each member of the Oregon
Congressional Delegation.

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
