## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 119

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert: 1  $\mathbf{2}$ "SECTION 1. ORS 622.080 is amended to read: 3 "622.080. (1)[(a)] Persons engaged in the growing, production, harvesting or distribution of shellfish who receive from such operations not more than [\$60,000] \$50,000 in annual gross income 4  $\mathbf{5}$ shall pay [the following] annual fees to the State Department of Agriculture[:]. The department 6 shall establish the amount of the annual fees by rule, not to exceed: 7 "[(A)] (a) [\$150] \$300 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a shucker-packer, for a person operating a shellfish shucking, packing or repacking plant for the distribution of shellfish. 8 9 "[(B)] (b) [\$100] \$200 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a grower, for a person engaged 10 in the business of growing shellfish. 11 "[(C)] (c) [\$100] \$200 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a distributor, for any jobber or 12wholesaler who furnishes or sells shellfish to retail outlets. 13 "[(D)] (d) [\$75] \$250 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a commercial harvester, for any 14 person harvesting clams or mussels for commercial purposes. 15"[(b) Notwithstanding the fees established in paragraph (a) of this subsection, no commercial fa-16 cility operating in one location shall pay more than \$250 in total annual fees to the department for any 17 combination of certificates issued under paragraph (a) of this subsection.] 18 (2)[(a)] Persons engaged in the growing, production, harvesting or distribution of shellfish who receive from such operations more than [\$60,000] \$50,000 but not more than \$500,000 in annual 19 20 gross income shall pay [the following] annual fees to the department[:]. The department shall es-21tablish the amount of the annual fees by rule, not to exceed: "[(A)] (a) [\$300] \$600 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a shucker-packer, for a person 22operating a shellfish shucking, packing or repacking plant for the distribution of shellfish. 2324 "[(B)] (b) [\$200] \$400 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a grower, for a person engaged 25in the business of growing shellfish. 26 "[(C)] (c) [\$225] \$450 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a distributor, for any jobber or 27wholesaler who furnishes or sells shellfish to retail outlets. 28"[(D)] (d) [\$75] \$250 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a commercial harvester, for any 29person harvesting clams or mussels for commercial purposes. 30 "[(b) Notwithstanding the fees established in paragraph (a) of this subsection, no commercial fa-31 cility operating in one location shall pay more than \$500 in total annual fees to the department for any 32combination of certificates issued under paragraph (a) of this subsection.]

"(3) Persons engaged in the growing, production, harvesting or distribution of shellfish
 who receive from such operations more than \$500,000 in annual gross income shall pay an nual fees to the department. The department shall establish the amount of the annual fees

1 by rule, not to exceed:

2 (a) \$1,200 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a shucker-packer, for a person operating a shellfish shucking, packing or repacking plant for the distribution of shellfish. 3

"(b) \$800 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a grower, for a person engaged in the 4 business of growing shellfish. 5

(c) \$900 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a distributor, for any jobber or 6 7 wholesaler who furnishes or sells shellfish to retail outlets.

(d) \$250 for a certificate of shellfish sanitation as a commercial harvester, for any per-8 son harvesting clams or mussels for commercial purposes. 9

"SECTION 2. ORS 622.290 is amended to read: 10

11 "622.290. (1) Persons using state lands for cultivating oysters, clams or mussels shall pay annual cultivation fees and use taxes quarterly to the State Department of Agriculture. Fees and taxes be-1213come delinquent 30 days after the end of the quarter.

"(2) Use taxes shall be in the amount of 10 cents per gallon of oysters if sold by the gallon, 10 14 cents per bushel of oysters if sold in the shell by the bushel or one cent per dozen oysters if sold 15 16 by the dozen.

"(3) Use taxes shall be in the amount of one-half cent per pound of clams or mussels sold.

18 "(4) The annual cultivation fee shall be [in the amount of \$4] established by department rule 19 in an amount not to exceed \$14 for each acre claimed pursuant to chapter 675, Oregon Laws 1969, 20 or claimed pursuant to a plat made subsequent thereto.

21(5) Annual cultivation fees and use taxes shall be assessed in lieu of property taxes, lease fees 22or rental charges for the use of lands upon which oysters, clams or mussels are grown and har-23vested.

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"SECTION 3. ORS 622.300 is amended to read:

25"622.300. All moneys received by the State Department of Agriculture under ORS 622.290 shall 26be paid over to the State Treasurer and deposited in the Department of Agriculture Service Fund 27and be subject to ORS 561.144. All such moneys are appropriated continuously to the department to carry out the provisions of [ORS 622.220 and 622.320] this chapter. 28

29 "SECTION 4. (1) The amendments to ORS 622.080 and 622.290 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2011 Act apply to fees assessed for annual periods that begin on or after July 1, 2011. The 30 Legislative Assembly intends that any initial rule adopted under ORS 622.080 or 628.290 by 31the State Department of Agriculture shall apply retroactively if necessary to allow charging 32and collection of the full fee amount established by rule for annual periods that begin on or 33 34after July 1, 2011.

35 "(2) If the department does not complete the adoption of initial rules under ORS 622.080 and 622.290 on or before July 1, 2011, for any annual period that begins on or after July 1, 36 37 2011, and prior to the initial rules taking effect, the department may elect to charge and 38 collect at the beginning of the annual period a partial payment equal to the applicable fee amount under ORS 622.080 and 622.290 as in effect immediately prior to the effective date of 39 40 the amendments to ORS 622.080 and 622.290 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2011 Act. If the de-41 partment elects to charge and collect a partial payment under this subsection, the department shall apply the full amount of the collected partial payment toward the annual fee 42amount due from the person under the applicable initial rule adopted by the department. 43

44 "(3) The amendments to ORS 622.300 by section 3 of this 2011 Act become operative July 45 1, 2011.

- 1 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
  on its passage.".
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
