

Senate Bill 185

Sponsored by Senator KRUSE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to study costs to state and school districts from federal education mandates. Requires study be completed by July 1, 2012.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to education; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall conduct a study on the projected**
5 **costs over the next 10 years resulting from federal education mandates that school districts**
6 **and education service districts in this state are required to comply with by federal law, or**
7 **required to comply with to receive federal moneys for educational purposes. The report shall**
8 **also calculate the projected cost over the next 10 years to the State of Oregon in complying**
9 **with the federal education mandates.**

10 **(2) The report shall be conducted by an independent entity chosen by the department**
11 **using a competitive bidding process.**

12 **(3) The department shall submit a copy of the report to the interim legislative committee**
13 **on education no later than July 1, 2012.**

14 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
