

# SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5513

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 7

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for  
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, of  
4 which the department may expend up to 54 percent during the period beginning July 1, 2011,  
5 and ending June 30, 2012, for the following purposes:

- 6 (1) Fish Division ..... \$ 5,175,443
- 7 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 793,838
- 8 (3) Administrative Services
- 9 Division ..... \$ 640,890
- 10 (4) Debt service ..... \$ 338,094
- 11 (5) Capital improvement..... \$ 142,194

12 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
13 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment  
14 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-  
15 cluding federal funds from the Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund, but excluding lottery  
16 funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the State De-  
17 partment of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

- 18 (1) Fish Division ..... \$ 66,770,907
- 19 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 38,818,764
- 20 (3) Administrative Services
- 21 Division ..... \$ 39,082,952
- 22 (4) Capital improvement..... \$ 7,711,722
- 23 (5) Department of State Police
- 24 enforcement contract ..... \$ 21,275,954

25 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
26 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment  
27 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to  
28 the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for activities and projects to implement section  
29 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Constitution, of which the department may expend up to 54  
30 percent during the period beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012, for the following  
31 purposes:

- 32 (1) Fish Division ..... \$ 4,531,217
- 33 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 1,293,181

34 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limits for payment

1 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2011 Act col-  
2 lected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

- 3 (1) Fish Division ..... \$ 86,750,972
- 4 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 20,939,782
- 5 (3) Administrative Services
- 6 Division ..... \$ 2,107,896

7 **“SECTION 5. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
8 **expenditures established by section 2 (2)(c), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium**  
9 **beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**  
10 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds for contract**  
11 **services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 668,**  
12 **Oregon Laws 2009, collected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife for**  
13 **wildlife diversity, is increased by \$100,000.**

14 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**  
15 **established by section 4 (1)(a), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning**  
16 **July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than**  
17 **those described in section 2, chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2009, collected or received by the**  
18 **State Department of Fish and Wildlife for fish propagation, is increased by \$1,350,000.**

19 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**  
20 **established by section 4 (2)(b), chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning**  
21 **July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than**  
22 **those described in section 2, chapter 668, Oregon Laws 2009, collected or received by the**  
23 **State Department of Fish and Wildlife for wildlife habitat, is increased by \$400,000.**

24 **“SECTION 6. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
25 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
26 **on its passage.”.**
