## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits Oregon Business Development Department to charge fees and administrative costs for program benefits provided, grants or loans made and administrative expenses incurred.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to charges assessed by the Oregon Business Development Department; creating new pro-

3 visions; and amending ORS 285A.200.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 285A.200 is amended to read:

6 285A.200. (1) The Oregon Business Development Department may accept gifts of money or other 7 property from any public or private agency or person made for the purpose of assisting the depart-8 ment to carry out any programs or laws that the department is charged with administering. Moneys 9 so received shall be paid into an appropriate fund or account. Property so received shall be used for 10 the purposes for which that property is given.

(2) The department may apply for, receive from the United States or any of its agencies, and
disburse or supervise the disbursement of federal aid for the purposes for which the aid is provided.
The department may also disburse or supervise the disbursement of funds provided by the State of
Oregon for expenditure as a condition of receiving the federal aid.

15 (3) The department may [assess and charge fees for loans made from any of its funds or 16 accounts] charge fees and administrative costs for program benefits provided, grants and 17 loans made and administrative expenses incurred by the department in the administration 18 of any program, fund or account under the department's direction and control.

19 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 285A.200 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to ad-20 ministrative expenses incurred, program benefits provided or grants or loans made by the 21 Oregon Business Development Department on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
