

Senate Bill 782

Sponsored by Senator EDWARDS, Representative SCHAUFLEER; Senators BOQUIST, FERRIOLI, PROZANSKI, Representatives CLEM, HOLVEY, MATTHEWS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires supervisory authority of county to forward to Employment Department certain information of defendant committed to supervisory authority.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. When a defendant is committed to the supervisory authority of the county**
5 **pursuant to ORS 137.124, the supervisory authority shall forward the name, date of birth and**
6 **Social Security number of the defendant to the Director of the Employment Department for**
7 **purposes of making a determination of eligibility under ORS 657.155.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
