- On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 15, insert:
- 2 "(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3) of this section, if the Department of

- 4 the total amount of registration fees collected pursuant to subsection (3) of
- 5 this section constitutes an amount that is at least \$250,000 less than if those

- 20 tration fees that would have been collected if those fees were collected at the
- 21 rate described in ORS 803.420 (10).
