- HB 4005 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes credit against income taxes in compensation for livestock killed by predators.
- HB 4006
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires State Fish and Wildlife Commission and State Department of Fish and Wildlife to advise, consult and cooperate with other state agencies, political subdivisions, other states, federal government and private landowners regarding fish and wildlife management.
- HB 4072
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows forest protective association to contract with Department of Transportation for association seasonal fire prevention and suppression personnel to render off-season services to department that indirectly facilitate fire prevention and suppression.
