HB 4035 A

Amends provisions of Oregon law to conform to changes in Uniform Commercial Code, to clarify meaning of name of debtor, to permit filing of information statement, to adopt official filing forms, to specify priority of competing secured claims, to specify source of law for securing vehicles exempt from Oregon titling requirements and to address related matters.

HB 4146 A

Requires expungement of juvenile records for contact involving prostitution when subject was under 18 years of age at time of offense without waiting period and, if no objection is filed, without hearing.
