Co-Chairs Clem, Esquivel, and Members of the Committee:

For the record, I am Rex Storm, Forest Policy Manager for Associated Oregon Loggers, Inc., located in Salem, Oregon. I speak on behalf of the statewide trade group's nearly 1,000 member companies. These companies engage in a full-range of forestry contract operations, including: harvest, fire protection, reforestation, transportation, construction, resource maintenance, and forestry services. Many of these firms also own family forestlands and pay fire protection assessments and tax.

I am also interested in this bill for two added reasons: as a member of the Board of Forestry's Fire Funding Committee; and as a tree farm owner and Oregon Small Woodlands Association member.

I am here today to support HB 4042 – Dash-1, and urge you to pass the bill.

Associated Oregon Loggers supports this bill because it would proactively strengthen fire defenses that ultimately should reduce long-term fire losses and firefighting costs. We support the bill's three key improvements:

- 1. Establish a cooperatively vertical split in large fire costs, phased-in over 4 years between landowners and the state General Fund
- 2. Increase the investment in annual "Severity funding," again split between landowners and General Fund
- 3. Reinforce the 50/50 share-cost cooperation between landowners and General Fund, with a "plus" emphasis on the public responsibility to protect forests

Passing these three key improvements would be very consistent with the on-going work of the Board of Forestry's Fire Funding Committee, which is working to bring on more comprehensive forest fire proposal to the 2013 Legislature.
