I am writing in support of SB 1510. I do so because of my concern with respect to the sustainability of the State's marine resources.

Oregon's Territorial Sea is a public resource, so all Oregonians share responsibility for managing it wisely for present and future generations. This legislation provides for both a short- and a long-term plan for effectively creating and adaptively managing marine protected areas and reserves by considering the needs of the local communities and the state as a whole – the ocean users, the businesses and organizations that depend on a healthy ocean, and the plants and animals that live in and around our waters.

I moved to Oregon from the Midwest five years ago, in part because of the beauty of the state – its mountains and its coast in particular.
