## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1525

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 2 and insert:

"SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2012 Act is added to and made a part
of ORS 181.610 to 181.712.

"SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an 5 individual who is employed full time by a tribal government to perform 6 the duties of a public safety officer and who possesses the requisite 7 qualifications may be certified or recertified as a police officer, certi-8 fied reserve officer, corrections officer, parole and probation officer, 9 fire service professional, telecommunicator or emergency medical dis-10 patcher if the individual and the tribal government comply with the 11 applicable provisions of ORS 181.610 to 181.712. 12

"(2) An individual who is certified under subsection (1) of this sec tion is considered to be employed as a full-time public safety officer
 in the discipline in which the certification is held for the following
 purposes:

"(a) Denying, suspending or revoking certification under ORS
18 181.661, 181.662 and 181.664;

"(b) Determining eligibility to apply for benefits from the Public
 Safety Memorial Fund under ORS 243.954 to 243.974; and

"(c) Determining eligibility to be honored at the memorial created
 pursuant to section 1, chapter 508, Oregon Laws 1987.

"SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect on its passage.".
