PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1574

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 16 and insert:

"(a) 'Convicted' includes the statutory counterpart in another jurisdiction
to the finding under Oregon law that a person is guilty except for insanity

4 of a crime.

5 "(b) 'Reciprocal license' means a license or permit issued in another state 6 that authorizes the licensee or permittee to carry a concealed handgun in the 7 state in which the license or permit is issued, if the other state:

"(A) Requires the prospective licensee or permittee to demonstrate competence with a handgun as a condition of issuing the license;

10 "(B) Requires the prospective licensee or permittee to submit to a 11 fingerprint-based criminal records check;

"(C) Requires the licensee or permittee to renew the license or permit at least once every seven years;

14 "(D) Prohibits the following persons from obtaining a license or permit:

15 "(i) Persons who are neither United States citizens nor legal resident al-16 iens;

17 "(ii) Persons who are under 21 years of age;

"(iii) Persons who have been convicted of a felony and who have not had
the right to possess a firearm restored;

"(iv) Persons who have been adjudicated as mentally ill by a court and
have not had the right to possess a firearm restored;

22 "(v) Persons who are charged with a crime or have outstanding warrants

1 for arrest;

"(vi) Persons who have been dishonorably discharged from the Armed
Forces of the United States; and

4 "(vii) Persons who are subject to a restraining order as defined in ORS
5 24.190;

"(E) Imposes eligibility requirements for the issuance of the license or
permit that are similar to the requirements described in ORS 166.291 (1)(h),
(k) and (L); and

9 "(F) Authorizes a person licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry
10 a concealed handgun in the other state.".

In line 17, delete "(b)" and insert "(c)".

12 After line 22, insert:

"(3) The Superintendent of State Police may enter into an agreement with officials of another state if an agreement is necessary for the other state to authorize persons licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a concealed handgun in the other state.".
