Measure Description:

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to convene work group to make recommendations regarding a system for performing criminal records checks. The bill requires DAS to report to the appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly on the workgroup's recommendations on or before November 30,2012

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure, as amended will require the Department of Administrative services to provide staffing for the workgroup and aid in the preparation and presentation of the workgroup's recommendations to the legislature. Due to the complicated legal questions anticipated, DAS has included \$16,773 in estimated legal services costs. No costs were included for workgroup participants.
