- Need for work group to establish community, state, and private partnerships in disaster preparedness •

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: House Joint Resolution 7 (2011) will be decided by Oregon voters in November 2012. It would revise the Oregon Constitution to authorize certain actions by the Governor and the Legislative Assembly during a catastrophic disaster. Should HJR 7 pass, Senate Bill 1561 would require the Homeland Security Council to receive briefings regarding same.
