## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Requires insurers to reimburse nurse practitioners at same rate as physicians for same services. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

| 8  | including prescribing or dispensing drugs, the insured under the policy is entitled to reimbursement   |
| 9  | for such service whether it is performed by a physician licensed by the Oregon Medical Board or        |
| 10 | by a duly licensed nurse practitioner.   |
| 11 | (2) The reimbursement shall be in the same amount as the reimbursement paid under the                  |

| 20 | SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public                  |
| 21 | peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect            |
