- 8 "(f) The number of construction hours worked.
- 9 "(g) The proportion of funds used for equipment purchase and new construction.
- 10 "(h) The percentage of jobs performed or contracts fulfilled by Oregon residents.
- 11 "(i) A description of increased program capacity resulting from the project.
- 12 "(j) A description of the local workforce need addressed by the project.".
