1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "appraisal" delete the rest of the line and delete line
2	3 and insert "; and declaring an emergency.".
3	Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 7 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'dispute' means a case or complaint handled by
5	the Appraiser Certification and Licensure Board that was filed:
6	"(a) By the board;
7	"(b) By an appraiser; or
8	"(c) By a property owner against an appraiser.
9	"(2) On or before May 1, 2013, the Appraiser Certification and Licensure Board shall
10	submit a report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner required by ORS 192.245 that
11	describes:
12	"(a) The board's procedures for dispute resolution, including:
13	"(A) Specific examples in which the board has been successful and unsuccessful in dealing
14	with dispute resolution;
15	"(B) Recommendations for addressing deficiencies in the dispute resolution procedures;
16	"(C) The number of times in the preceding two years that the board has used the dispute
17	resolution procedures; and
18	"(D) Whether there is a panel that reviews each complaint submitted to the board to
19	determine the legitimacy of the complaint;
20	"(b) The board's procedures relating to conflicts of interest among board members, in-
21	cluding:
22	"(A) Guidelines set by the Oregon Government Ethics Commission;
23	"(B) The procedure for removing a board member when a conflict of interest exists;
24	"(C) Recommendations for addressing deficiencies in the conflict of interest procedures;
25	and
26	"(D) How many conflicts of interest have occurred in the past two years; and
27	"(c) The current process by which a person becomes an appraiser, including:
28	"(A) Whether the board has identified any barriers to becoming certified or licensed as
29	an appraiser;
30	"(B) The purpose of any barriers the board has identified;
31	"(C) How many appraisers are employed in this state;
32	"(D) How many appraisers have been suspended or reprimanded in the last two years;
33	"(E) How many people apply for certification or licensure each year; and
34	"(F) Recommendations for reducing barriers to entry into the appraisal field.
35	" <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

- 1 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect
- 2 on its passage.".

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
