

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5702

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “creating new provisions; amending sec-
2 tion 7, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 18 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-
5 tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Develop-
6 ment Department established by section 3 (1), chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the
7 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$139,171.

8 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services
9 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Development Depart-
10 ment established by section 3 (2), chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning
11 July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$293,896.

12 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services
13 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Development Depart-
14 ment established by section 3 (3), chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning
15 July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$81,315.

16 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
17 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Education, for
18 the State School Fund, established by section 4, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the
19 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$2,979,570.

20 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
21 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the office of the Governor estab-
22 lished by section 6, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,
23 is decreased by \$943.

24 “**SECTION 4.** Section 7, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read:

25 “**Sec. 7.** (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall establish a process for al-
26 locating available moneys in the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund on a quar-
27 terly basis to fulfill the biennial allocations made by [this 2011 Act] **chapter 622, Oregon Laws**
28 **2011**. The department shall set the quarterly allocations.

29 “(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Administrative
30 Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by
31 [this 2011 Act] **chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011**, prior to making any other allocations pursuant to
32 [this 2011 Act] **chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011**, the department shall satisfy lottery bond debt ser-
33 vice obligations in the amount of [\$240,443,627] **\$248,243,839**, as follows:

34 (a) For outstanding lottery bonds [\$ 238,307,273]

35 \$ 246,353,489

1 (b) For lottery bonds to be issued [~~\$ 2,136,354~~]
2 \$ 1,890,350

3 “(3) After the lottery bond debt service obligations described in subsection (2) of this section
4 are satisfied, if the remaining moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund to the Administrative
5 Services Economic Development Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations made by
6 [*this 2011 Act*] **chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011**, the department shall reduce allocations propor-
7 tionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

8 “**SECTION 5.** (1) **Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
9 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Ad-**
10 **ministrative Services, established by section 8 (1), chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the**
11 **biennium beginning July 1, 2011, is increased by \$8,046,216.**

12 “(2) **Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services**
13 **Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative**
14 **Services, established by section 8 (2), chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium be-**
15 **ginning July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$246,004.**

16 “**SECTION 6.** **Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
17 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Sports Lottery Account estab-**
18 **lished by section 9, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011,**
19 **is decreased by \$232,960.**

20 “**SECTION 7.** **Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
21 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment**
22 **Fund, established by section 11, chapter 622, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning**
23 **July 1, 2011, is decreased by \$390,969.**

24 “**SECTION 8.** **Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Criminal Fine**
25 **and Assessment Account and the Criminal Fine Account, the allocation to the Department**
26 **of Public Safety Standards and Training established by section 54, chapter 597, Oregon Laws**
27 **2011, for the period beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, for the purpose of**
28 **criminal justice training and standards operations, is decreased by \$873,897.**

29 “**SECTION 9.** **This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
30 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect**
31 **on its passage.”.**
