11 "(C) One member who represents the Department of Education;

"(D) One member who represents kindergarten through grade 12 education
as a career and technical education teacher;

14 "(E) One member who represents community colleges as a career and 15 technical education teacher;

"(F) One member who represents universities as a science, technology,
 engineering or mathematics faculty member;

18 "(G) One member who represents universities as a provost;

"(H) Two members who represent organizations pursuing science, tech nology, engineering or mathematics mentorships, internships and partner ships;

²² "(I) One high school student with an interest in science, technology, en-

1 gineering or mathematics; and

"(J) One community college or university student majoring in a science,
technology, engineering or mathematics field.".

4 On page 2, delete lines 30 through 35 and insert:

"(12)(a) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the task force who are
members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage expenses
or per diem payments and serve as volunteers on the task force.

8 "(b) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative 9 Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses 10 and serve as volunteers on the task force.".

11 After line 39, insert:

"(14) The task force may accept donations of staff support, office space
and equipment from businesses and advocacy organizations to assist the task
force in the performance of its functions.".
