Work Session

HB 2535

Requires workers' compensation premium rates for clients of temporary service provider to be based on client's experience rating.

HB 2540

Allows Construction Contractors Board to revoke, suspend or refuse to issue license if board finds person has engaged in dishonesty by enabling evasion of certain obligations.

HB 3005

Authorizes person with legal estate in real property to evict person in possession of real property under lease or rent agreement for conduct that causes place to be nuisance.

HB 3263 **

Requires State of Oregon to grant paid leave to eligible employees who are victims of domestic violence, harassmer sexual assault or stalking.

HB 3459 **

Establishes Office of Small Business Assistance in Office of Secretary of State for purpose of facilitating interactions between small businesses and state agencies with regulatory authority over small businesses.
