HB 2239

Requires certain entities previously exempt from requirement to have license in order to engage in business of maki mortgage loans to now obtain license from Department of Consumer and Business Services.

Public Hearing

HB 2059

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires consignee to refrain from certain practices and to hold moneys consignee receives from sale of personal property in trust account if consignee does not pay moneys immediately to person the offered, gave or entrusted personal property to consignee.

HB 2060

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows Attorney General to issue order disqualifying charitable organization from receiving contributions that are deductible for purpose of Oregon income tax and corporate excise tax if Attorney General finds that charitable organization has failed to expend at least 30 percent of total annual functional expenses on program services when those expenses are averaged over most recent three fiscal years.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies laws relating to transfers of structured settlement payment rights.
