HB 2650

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires medical services contract to contain provision prohibiting health care provider from referring claim for reimbursement of health services to collection agency until provider has exhausted insurer's procedures for contesting denial, underpayment or refund of claim, notified patient of claim and given patient reasonable time to pay claim.

HB 2826

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes requirements under which debt buyer may bring legal action to collect debt

HB 3017

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires financial institution that has contract with state agency to disburse government benefit to individual by means of debit card to disclose fees for using debit card or in connection with debit card to individual and state agency.

HB 3174

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows Oregon resident filing for bankruptcy to either claim exemptions established by federal law or claim exemptions established by state law.

Work Session

HB 2821

Modifies amount of reimbursement due personal injury protection provider when total benefits exceed damages.

HB 2662

Prohibits owner of foreclosed residential real property from neglecting foreclosed residential real property during period of vacancy.

HB 3144 **

Revises language regarding assumption of administration and enforcement of manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or partial building inspection program after municipality ceases administration and enforcement.
