Work Session

- HB 2662
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2013 AGENDA: Prohibits owner of foreclosed residential real property from neglecting foreclosed residential real property during period of vacancy.
- HB 2207
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2013 AGENDA: Requires payment of state payroll to be made through direct electronic deposit.
- HB 2978
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2013 AGENDA: Sets out uniform provisions for certain aspects of state building code administration and enforcement.
- HB 2822
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2013 AGENDA: Disallows publication of notice of sale of real property by Internet posting without additional publication in newspaper of general circulation.
- HB 2929
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/04/2013 AGENDA: Provides penalty of \$500 for trustee's failure to give notice of trustee's sale postponement in accordance with requirements.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Governor's budget report submitted to Legislative Assembly to describe, for each state agency, percentage of expenditures made in Oregon by agency under contracts for goods or services.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Creates disclosure requirements related to use of refund anticipation payment instruments by tax consultants and tax preparers.
