#### Work Session

- HB 2453 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-8-2013: Requires persons operating certain high-mileage motor vehicles to pay per-mile road usage charge or flat annual road usage charge.
- HB 2894 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-8-2013: For purposes of tax credits for energy conservation projects, increases amount of eligible cost for which credit may be claimed using informational filing system in place of certification and for which entire credit may be claimed in first allowable tax year.
- HB 3495  
Requires persons that facilitate like-kind exchanges to make certain notifications and to provide bonds or other securities in specified amounts.
- For the purposes of considering an amendment.*
- HB 2460  
Authorizes state agencies, boards and commissions that issue grants to require grant applicants to demonstrate and maintain tax compliance as condition of issuance or renewal of grant.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 184  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-8-2013: Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.
- SB 185  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-8-2013: Creates specific provisions relating to garnishment by Department of Revenue
- SB 24  
Specifies certain moneys to be credited to Distributable Income Account within Common School Fund.
- SB 528 A  
Allows Secretary of State, State Treasurer, judicial department and legislative department to obtain copyrights and patents on data processing materials and to sell, lease or otherwise make available the materials to local, state and federal governmental bodies.
