Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 215
Prohibits State Board of Education from adopting rules or imposing sanctions related to use of mascots by public schools.
- SB 501
Prohibits State Board of Education from adopting standards or rules that permit Superintendent of Public Instruction to find school district to be nonstandard or to withhold moneys or impose sanctions related to use of mascot by public school.
- SB 702
Directs Oregon Student Access Commission to award at least 50 percent of Oregon Opportunity Grant moneys awarded each year to qualified students majoring in science, technology, engineering or mathematical fields.
- HB 2913
Clarifies that committee formed by Department of Education and Bureau of Labor and Industries is established to set goals, develop grant criteria, review grant applications and make recommendations related to awarding grants under Career and Technical Education Revitalization Grant Program.
- HB 2386
Prohibits school district from requiring student to wear, carry or use any item with radio frequency identification device if device is used for purpose of locating or tracking student or taking attendance.
